

**All Stacked Up**  
**Instructor Daune (Dawn) Walker**

Quilt size 64 x 72

Block size 8 1/2"



Kaffe Fassett Fabric

**“All Stacked Up”** is not your tradition quilt pattern. You will need to think outside the “box” on this one. I would suggest you bring a flannel backed vinyl tablecloth. This is definitely a “design wall” quilt!

Fabric requirements are 51 pieces of fabric ranging from one-eighth to one-fourth yards of Kaffe Fassett. This can be considerably expensive, so I suggest using scraps or fat quarters and repeat several of the blocks! I used Riley Blake remnants and all the polka dots and chevrons I had in my stash!

**Pattern Cost - \$5.00**

**Fabric Requirements:**

10 to 15 fat quarters - flowers, birds, prints - (Outer Strip and center triangle)

5 to 10 fat quarters polka dot, solid, chevron (Inner Strip)

1 yard white

4 yards backing

5/8 yard binding – pattern used a dark Kaffe Fassett (I used a small pin dot of all colors in quilt)

### **Cutting Directions for Prints**

Fabrics A to Z are referred as the outer strip and the center triangle.

### **FABRICS A, B, C, D, F, G, I, J, K, L, N, O, O, P, R, T, U, V, W, AND Y**

CUT 2 - 5" SQUARES  
3 - 2 1/2 X 6 1/2  
3 - 2 1/2 X 8 1/2

### **Fabrics - E, M, Q, X AND Z**

Cut 1 - 5" square  
2 - 2 1/2 x 6 1/2  
2 - 2 1/2 x 8 1/2

### **Fabric H**

Cut 1 - 5" squares  
Cut 1 - 2 1/2 x 6 1/2  
Cut 1 - 2 1/2 x 8 1/2

### **Fabric S**

Cut 2 - 5" squares  
Cut 4 - 2 1/2 x 6 1/2  
Cut 4 - 2 1/2 x 8 1/2

### **Cutting directions for Solids**

Fabrics AA – ZZ are referred to as Inner Strip fabrics.

### **Fabrics – AA, BB, CC, DD, FF, GG, II, JJ, KK, LL, NN, OO, PP, RR, TT, UU, VV, WW, YY**

Cut 3 - 2 1/2 x 4 1/2  
Cut 3 - 2 1/2 x 6 1/2

### **Fabric HH**

Cut 1 - 2 1/2 x 4 1/2  
Cut 1 - 2 1/2 x 6 1/2

### **Fabric SS**

Cut 4 - 2 1/2 x 4 1/2  
Cut 4 - 2 1/2 x 6 1/2

### **FABRICS EE, MM, QQ, XX, AND ZZ**

CUT 2 - 2 1/2 X 4 1/2  
2 - 2 1/2 X 6 1/2

### **Background**

Cut 6 - 5" x wof strips; Subcut into (48) 5" squares

### **Binding**

Cut 7 – 2 ½ x wof strips

**Hint:**

Pair up Outer Strip fabric with Inner Strip fabric. For example: Fabric A with Fabric AA. Keep the parts together for the block building steps.
