



CIRCLE OF STARS 18" finished block

***ALL SIZES ARE WITHOUT BORDERS**

***Always cut the larger pieces first.**

***wof = width of fabric (44")**

***Background:** you can use multiple fabrics as long as the value remains consistent.

****For the star points on larger quilts (background and color squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ " X $2\frac{7}{8}$ ") you can substitute your favorite speed piecing method instead of cutting individual squares for points and backgrounds. Adjust yardage to accommodate your piecing method.**

ONE BLOCK

Background: you can use multiple fabrics as long as the value remains consistent. A Fat Quarter is not large enough to get all the background pieces. I used one fabric for the main background and another for the background behind the star points. You can mix it up any way you choose. To use one fabric - about 22" X 22".

Cut:

- 1 piece $6\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 4 pieces $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $8\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 4 pieces $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 8 pieces $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 16 pieces $2\frac{7}{8}$ " X $2\frac{7}{8}$ "

Stars: There are 8 stars in each block. I used 8 different fabrics but you can repeat fabrics.

From each fabric (8 fabrics - scrap at least 3" X 9") cut:

- 2 pieces $2\frac{7}{8}$ " X $2\frac{7}{8}$ " - star points
- 1 piece $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $2\frac{1}{2}$ " - star center

WALLHANGING 2 blocks across and 2 blocks down 4 blocks total 36" X 36"

Background: 1 1/2 yards

Cut:

4 piece 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" - cut 1 strip 6 1/2" X wof - subcut into 4 squares 6 1/2" X 6 1/2"

16 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2" - cut 4 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 16 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2"

16 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" - cut 2 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 16 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2"

32 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - cut 2 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 32 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

**64 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - cut 5 strips 2 7/8" X wof - subcut into 64 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

****For the star points on larger quilts (background and color squares 2 7/8" X 2 7/8") you can substitute your favorite speed piecing method instead of cutting individual squares for points and backgrounds.**

Stars: There are 8 stars in each block. I used 8 different fabrics but you can repeat fabrics.

From each fabric (8 fabrics - at least 3" X 35") cut:

**8 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - star points

4 piece 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - star center

LAP 3 blocks across and 4 blocks down 12 blocks total 54" X 72"

Background: 3 1/2 yards

Cut:

12 pieces 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" - cut 2 strips 6 1/2" X wof - subcut into 12 squares 6 1/2" X 6 1/2"

48 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2" - cut 12 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 48 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2"

48 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" - cut 6 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 48 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2"

96 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - cut 6 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 96 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

**192 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - cut 15 strips 2 7/8" X wof - subcut into 192 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

****For the star points on larger quilts (background and color squares 2 7/8" X 2 7/8") you can substitute your favorite speed piecing method instead of cutting individual squares for points and backgrounds. Adjust yardage to accommodate your piecing method.**

Stars: There are 8 stars in each block. I used 8 different fabrics but you can repeat fabrics.

8 fabrics 1/4 yard each (Fat or regular quarter)

From each fabric cut:

**24 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - star points - cut 2 strips 2 7/8" X wof and subcut into 24 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

12 piece 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - star center - cut 1 strip 2 1/2" X wof and submit into 12 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

FULL/QUEEN with added borders

4 blocks across and 5 blocks down 20 blocks total 72" X 90"-size without borders

Background: 6 yards

Cut:

20 pieces 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" - cut 4 strips 6 1/2" X wof - subcut into 20 squares 6 1/2" X 6 1/2"

80 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2" - cut 20 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 80 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2"

80 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" - cut 10 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 80 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2"

160 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - cut 10 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 160 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

**320 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - cut 25 strips 2 7/8" X wof - subcut into 320 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

****For the star points on larger quilts (background and color squares 2 7/8" X 2 7/8") you can substitute your favorite speed piecing method instead of cutting individual squares for points and backgrounds. Adjust yardage to accommodate your piecing method.**

Stars: There are 8 stars in each block. I used 8 different fabrics but you can repeat fabrics. 8 fabrics 1/2 yard each.

From each fabric cut:

**40 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - star points - cut 3 strips 2 7/8" X wof and subcut into 40 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

20 piece 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - star center - cut 2 strips 2 1/2" X wof and subcut into 20 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

KING with added borders

5 blocks across and 5 blocks down 25 blocks total 90" X 90" - size without borders

Background: 7 1/2 yards

Cut:

25 pieces 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" - cut 4 strips 6 1/2" X wof - subcut into 24 squares 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" - that's 24. You will need to cut 1 more!

100 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2" - cut 25 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 100 pieces 2 1/2" X 8 1/2"

100 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" - cut 13 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 100 pieces 2 1/2" X 4 1/2"

200 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - cut 13 strips 2 1/2" X wof - subcut into 200 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

**400 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - cut 31 strips 2 7/8" X wof - subcut into 400 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

****For the star points on larger quilts (background and color squares 2 7/8" X 2 7/8") you can substitute your favorite speed piecing method instead of cutting individual squares for points and backgrounds. Adjust yardage to accommodate your piecing method.**

Stars: There are 8 stars in each block. I used 8 different fabrics but you can repeat fabrics. 8 fabrics 1/2 yard each. You will need 17" so add extra if you are unsure of your cutting!

From each fabric cut:

**50 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" - star points - cut 4 strips 2 7/8" X wof and subcut into 50 pieces 2 7/8" X 2 7/8"

25 piece 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" - star center - cut 2 strips 2 1/2" X wof and subcut into 25 pieces 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

If you see something that is obviously wrong or something you have a question about, let me know before you cut so I can check my math!!!

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
