Supplies

7greens-1 yd each-background

1 additional green-2 yds-background-also used for the inner border.

Yellow-2 various fat quarters (FQs)

Yellow-orange- 3 various FQ

Orange-3 various FQ

Orange-medium/dark 2FQ-can be the same fabric

Pink-7 various FQ

Purple-5 various FQ

Cream/white-3 various FQ

Light green-2 various FQ-centers and small flowers

Binding-3/4 yd-repeat of a background fabric

Backing-5 ½ yds

Other supplies

Freezer paper- takes a lot, start with a new box

Tracing paper-needs to be wide

Roxanne's glue baste it

8 ½ yards Totally Stable or comparable stabilizer. Needs to be iron on but removable. I used the Totally Stable and the only problem was a residue after removal. I scraped most of it off with a credit card. It probably could have been left but I am a little funny about this kind of thing.

Thread to match flower fabrics. Everything except the greens are for flowers. Aurifil has a box of threads in the various colors needed for the quilt.

Sewing machine that you know how to operate. Just in case bring your instruction book.

Basic sewing supplies

Tracing pens and pencils. I used a fine line sharpie and mechanical pencils.

Order your patterns soon as it gives you a lot of cutting instructions especially for the backgrounds and the stabilizer.

I found a kit of the Island Batik fabrics at www.homespunhearth.com. These are the fabrics used in the pattern.
