

Garden Party

Supply List

2/3 yards of 6 different fabrics for the backgrounds

10" x WOF of 1 fabric for flower centers

6" x WOF or comparable yardage of at least 25 fabrics for the flowers, leaves and butterflies

(I just used my stash)

8 yards of 24" fusible (pattern recommends Steam a Seam 2, I like Heat and Bond Lite, buy it by the roll at Wal-Mart, It's cheaper than the quilt shop)

Appliqué pressing sheet

1/3 yard each of 4 different fabrics for sashings (I used one fabric)

6" x WOF for corner stones

5 1/4 yards for backing

Thread for appliqué (I like to match thread to appliqué fabrics, but you can use a neutral, beige or medium gray)

Monofilament thread (I used this to free motion appliqué the tiny hearts)

1 yard of tear away stabilizer

Sewing machine that you know how to operate, bring the manual just in case

Other sewing notions

Iron to share and ironing surface

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Pre-class

Reverse the pattern before you trace the pattern onto fusible. I used a Sharpie and traced the image onto the back of the pattern sheet. I numbered all the parts on the reversed copy and also as I transferred the pattern to the paper side of the fusible.

You will need 12 of each piece.

For the stems you can trace the pattern or iron fusible to the back of fabric and just cut bias strips. I'll show you how to make the curve as you iron it to your fabric.
