

SUNFLOWER SPLASH WALL QUILT

SUPPLY LIST:

\$10. Pattern 'Sunflower Splash' by Judy Lilly
Sewing machine with $\frac{1}{4}$ ", open toe and free motion feet
18" x 24" cutting mat; rotary cutter; 6" x 24" ruler
Small sharp scissors and paper scissors
Teflon press sheet or parchment paper
Basic sewing kit: pins, seam ripper, stiletto, chalk marker, etc.
Invisible thread in both clear and smoke
Neutral sewing thread
Lightweight bobbin thread (#50 or #60 neutral color)
#70 Microtex sewing machine needles (by Schmetz)
Fine point black Sharpie marker
Variety of lightweight embroidery threads in colors that blend
with your chosen flower and leaf fabrics; large square ruler
Optional: iron and ironing surface; pencil and paper

FABRICS, ETC:

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards Golden Threads tracing paper
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards Wonder Under (no substitutes, please!)
3 yards Totally Stable stabilizer
2 yards dark background fabric
4-6 fat quarters bright yellow, yellow orange and rusty orange
3 fat quarters in various shades of green for stem and leaves
10" x 10" brown fabric for flower center
 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard inner border fabric
36" x 50" batting and backing
 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard binding
