Sewing Machine, in good working order. Bring your instruction manual. If your machine has a **slide on table/extension that goes over the free arm**, bring that too.

1/4" presser foot-without a side blade/guide. This is a must! This should be available from your dealer or on line. If you

have a Bernina it's a #37 foot. We have a few generic 1/4" feet in stock but I cannot guarantee they will fit all brands of machines.

Rotary cutter and medium size **mat**-whatever you have-don't buy another mat because you don't have the exact mat listed.

6" x 12" **ruler** or something similar-it's for sub-cutting 9-patch units. 6" x 24" ruler, if you haven't done your cutting before class.



Star Chain

General information:

All seams are 1/4"

9-Patch Blocks

Strips for the 9-patch blocks are cut 2 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF).

and sub-cut into 2 1/2" units.

Press seams toward the darker fabric.

Blocks should finish 6" x 6" (6 1/2" x 6 1/2" including seam allowance).

Peaky & Spike Blocks

Use Marti Mitchell's Multi-Size Peaky & Spike template set.

Cut pieces using the 6" finished size measurements.

The sample quilt was made using many different fabrics, a scrap quilt, so these yardages are general recommendations. If you want to have specific placement plan you might need to re-figure yardage to meet your particular needs.

BORDERS

I added one border to these measurements so if you want multiple borders you will need to add to the measurements here.

Bias binding is included in the border fabric. You might consider using some of the border fabric to increase the width of your backing, if you are using 45" fabrics...2 pieces never seem to be wide enough.

Yardage for Bias Binding only:

LAP 3/4 yd.

FULL/QUEEN 1 yd.

KING 1 1/4 yds.

Yardage is simply broken into Light and Dark fabrics.

LAP SIZE 42" x 66" - patchwork only. With 4 1/2" border 51" x 75"

9 Patch blocks







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One strip light and dark will make 3 blocks Cut 2 dark strips 2 1/2" x 16". Cut 1 dark strip 2 1/2" x 8 1/2". Cut 2 light strips 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Cut 1 light strip 2 1/2" x 16"

Subcut units 2 1/2" wide.

9-patch blocks within stars






Subcut units 2 1/2" wide.

These 9-patch blocks can either match or contrast the fabrics used in the star points.

Cut 2 dark strips 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Cut 1 dark strip 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 2 light strips 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 1 light strip 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

These measurements allow plenty of length the straighten the edge before cutting the units to be used in the blocks.

Press all seams toward the dark fabric. Press seams allowances from the right side so that there is not a small pleat at the seam which will make it harder to get perfect alignment of seams.



Finished block should measure 6" x 6" Block including seam allowances should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



STARS

Use Marti Michell's Multi-Size Peaky & Spike template set. This set has engineered corners so the corners align perfectly and you get uniform points and 1/4" seam allowances.

Cut 4 matching triangles for each star.

Background pieces have to be cut mirror imaged - 4 Left and 4 Right. The easiest way to do this is to fold the fabric wrong sides together and cut background triangles 2 at a time-1 left and 1 right. You will need 4 sets for each star.




Colorful fabric-star points This takes a piece of fabric about 7" x 18" for each star.

Construction details for the Peaky & Spike portion of this block are included in the template packaging.




Background fabric for stars -This takes a piece of fabric about 7" x 18".

Remember: this strip of fabric is folded in half so you are cutting through 2 layers at a time, cutting a total of 8 triangles, 4 left side, 4 right side for each Peaky & Spike Star.




Press seam allowances toward the 9-patch blocks. Star Chain - Lap Size

7 blocks across - n blocks down 42" x 66" Patchwork only. Add borders




Make 31 9-patch blocks, randon colors. Press the seams toward the darker fabric.



Make 8 star blocks.





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13 blocks across - 15 blocks down 78" x 90" Patchwork only. Add borders



Make 77 9-patch blocks, randon colors. Press the seams toward the darker fabric.




Make 21 star blocks.

4 Peaky & Spike blocks needed for each star. 84 total but make sure they are cut in groups of 4 matching triangles so the 4 star points of each star will match.





Make 113 9-patch blocks, randon colors. Press the seams toward the darker fabric.




Make 32 star blocks.
