

## SUMMER WEDDING

When choosing fabric pay attention to value, not color-any colors will work, but make sure all your fabrics contrast to your background fabrics so the rings will show equally.

**NOTE:** I added a colored border which you might like to consider. **The only size in this listing that has a border included in the information is the Full/Queen Square, which is the size I made.**

**"Solid E block" would be appropriate if you are using a single background fabric not a variety of fabrics for the background as shown in the pattern or my sample quilt.**

**THROW**—51" X 69"

Medium to Dark Scraps ("H" units) 1 1/2 yards total  
Light Background-Variety of fabrics 2 1/2 yards total  
Border 3/4 yards  
Binding 1/2 yard  
Backing 3 1/2 yards

### **Background:**

(4) 6 1/2" squares (Block A)  
(24) 5" squares (Four-Patch centers-Block E)  
NOTE: for a solid Block E cut (6) 9 1/2" squares  
(6) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (Block B)  
(57) 3 1/2" squares Blocks A, B, C, D)  
(102) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle (Block D)  
(66) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips ("H"units)

### **Medium to Dark Scraps** (136 "H" units)

(34) 1 1/2" x WOF strips\*\*—then cut from each strip:  
(1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle  
(8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle  
\*\*Each WOF strips will make (4) "H" units

### **Border**

(6) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

### **Binding**

(6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. I cut binding on the bias but the yardage should be adequate for bias binding.

**Twin**—69" X 87"

Medium to Dark Scraps ("H" units) 2 3/4 yards total  
Light Background-Variety of fabrics 4 1/2 yards total  
Border 1 yard  
Binding 3/4 yard  
Backing 5 1/2 yards

**Background:**

(4) 6 1/2" squares (Block A)  
(48) 5" squares (Four-Patch centers-Block E)  
NOTE: for a solid Block E cut (12) 9 1/2" squares  
(10) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (Block B)  
(103) 3 1/2" squares Blocks A, B, C, D)  
(186) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle (Block D)  
(124) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips ("H"units)

**Medium to Dark Scraps (248 "H" units)**

(62) 1 1/2" x WOF strips\*\*—then cut from each strip:

(1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle

(8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

\*\*Each WOF strips will make (4) "H" units

**Border**

(8) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

**Binding**

(8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. \*\*I cut binding on the bias but the yardage should be adequate for bias binding.

**I made my sample quilt square because I wanted to add a colored border and the size given in the pattern was going to be too long when I added another border. Here's the cutting info for the size I made. I added a 5" border but you could add any size you want.**

**Full/Queen-Square 87" x 87" + Border (97" x 97")**

**Background:**

(4) 6 1/2" squares (Block A)

(64) 5" squares (Four-Patch centers-Block E) OR

Cut (8) 5" x width of fabric (WOF) to strip piece center blocks-8 strips total but should be several different fabrics. OR

NOTE: for a solid Block E cut (16) 9 1/2" squares

(12) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (Block B)

(138) 3 1/2" squares Blocks A, B, C, D)

(240) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle (Block D)

(160) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips ("H"units)

**Medium to Dark Scraps (248 "H" units)**

(80) 1 1/2" x WOF strips\*\*—then cut from each strip:

(1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle

(8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

\*\*Each WOF strips will make (4) "H" units

**Border**

(9) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

**Full/Queen—87" X 105"**

Medium to Dark Scraps ("H" units) 4 1/4 yards total

Light Background-Variety of fabrics 6 yards total

Border 1 1/4 yard

Binding 3/4 yard

Backing 9 1/2 yards

**Background:**

(4) 6 1/2" squares (Block A)

(80) 5" squares (Four-Patch centers-Block E)

NOTE: for a solid Block E cut (20) 9 1/2" squares

(14) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (Block B)

(163) 3 1/2" squares Blocks A, B, C, D)

(294) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle (Block D)

(196) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips ("H"units)

**Medium to Dark Scraps (248 "H" units)**

(98) 1 1/2" x WOF strips\*\*—then cut from each strip:

(1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle

(8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

\*\*Each WOF strips will make (4) "H" units

**Border**

(9) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

**Binding**

(10) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. \*\*I cut binding on the bias but the yardage should be adequate for bias binding.

**King—105" X 105"**

Medium to Dark Scraps ("H" units) 5 1/4 yards total

Light Background-Variety of fabrics 7 1/2 yards total

Border 1 1/2 yard

Binding 1 yard

Backing 9 1/2 yards

**Background:**

(4) 6 1/2" squares (Block A)

(100) 5" squares (Four-Patch centers-Block E)

NOTE: for a solid Block E cut (25) 9 1/2" squares

(16) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (Block B)

(200) 3 1/2" squares Blocks A, B, C, D)  
(360) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle (Block D)  
(240) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips ("H"units)

**Medium to Dark Scraps** (248 "H" units)

(120) 1 1/2" x WOF strips\*\*—then cut from each strip:

(1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle

(8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

\*\*Each WOF strips will make (4) "H" units

**Border**

(10) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

**Binding**

(11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. \*\*I cut binding on the bias but the yardage should be adequate for bias binding.

Bring your sewing machine with a 1/4" foot, without a side blade and the top extension, sewing surface, table, whatever you call it...the thing that fits over your free arm to expand the sewing surface.

Neutral thread

Pins

Scissors

Rotary cutter and cutting mat-smaller size is fine

Cushion to sit on, if you need one

Basic sewing supplies...that's anything you think I forgot to list.
