

Tuffet Class (Yes, you really can complete this in one day.)

Melissa Wells has designed a fun and fast way to sew a tuffet that will allow you to change covers using the same foundation. In class you will sew and construct the tuffet. The button is removable, so changing covers for all occasions is easy and fun. So you can make covers for Christmas, Easter, summer, 4th of July, fall, your favorite ball team or just because you can. The possibilities are endless! They make great gifts. You will want to make more when you see how easy they are to make!

Student requirements: sewing machine, 1/4" piecing foot if you have one, #90 sharp needles,

1/4 yard of 6 different fabrics or 6 Fat Quarters (Quilters Cotton Fabric). Yes, you can use a jelly roll... So here's the scoop - you can use jelly rolls, but you need to cut them down to 2" x 21" strips before class. Put them in order you want them to go around on your Tuffet (unless you don't care where the colors end up) and number them 1-36. You need (36) 2" x 21" pieces.

5" x 5" square of fabric for covered button.

18" x 18" square fabric for bottom of Tuffet.

2 yards light to medium weight fusible interfacing.

Strong thread (all purpose polyester thread).

2 buttons, 3/4" or 1" to match your bottom fabric. Matching thread to sew on buttons.

Rotary cutter - we will be cutting layers so please make sure you have a new blade.

4 feet to attach to bottom of tuffet. (You do not need these for class - Lowes or Home Depot carry them or you can get them online).

The price of the kit is \$95 and includes the pattern and ruler. Payment for the kit needs to be paid to The Happy Cottage by November 1. You can pay by check and mail to PO Box 2309, Murrells Inlet, SC 29576, or by credit card by calling (803) 500-1511. The kit will include everything you need except tuffet feet and fabric. (PLEASE NO UPHOLSTERY FABRIC)
